Dear Comrades,

- A) It is a matter of deep concern that in recent past it is observed that the BSNL Authority is trying to cut salaries of Casual and Contractor labourers in the name of austerity measure or financial curtailment. But they do not care to minimize any other unwanted expenditure to make BSNL financially viable or to make it a profitable PSU again. The situation is no doubt grave and to fight against this the Circle/District leaders are requested to organize their members and start demonstration programme against this inhuman attitude of the Authorities. The BSNLEU Leaders are also requested to extend their solidarity and support to the Casual/Contract Labourers programme.
- B) It is most astonishing that in some Circles the Authority has taken unilateral decision to retrench the Casual/Contract Labourers. Even the BSNLCCWF Central Office Bearers are no exception. We have to raise our voice against these anti labour policies of the Authority. The Circle/Dist Leaders are at once requested to organize demonstration programme in consultation with the BSNLEU Leadership.
- C) You are already aware of the fact that the BSNL CO has already published their Circular regarding the wage of Casual and Contract Labourers of BSNL establishment. But in case of the wage of the Contract Labourers in most of the Circles the guideline as issued by the BSNLCO New Delhi is blatantly violated and the Contract Labourers do not get their prescribed rates. This should not be tolerated and to get the just wage Circle and District leaders are requested to take appropriate programme in their Workspots.
- D) **It is learnt that the All India Public Sector Trade Union Leaders have decided to organize countrywide programme on 21<sup>st</sup> December' 2010 to protect the rights and demands of Casual and Contract Labourers throughout the Country.** We have to make this programme a grand success. The Circle and District leaders are directed to take all initiatives to organize programmes with maximum number of members; the leaders are also directed to consult BSNLEU Leaders of their areas to make joint programme if the situation permits.
